Important note: The application process takes place exclusively online. Your application will only be considered if correctly submitted in the online application portal within the application period from 15th of April 2024 to 16th of May 2024 with all required documents attached. Please fill in this application agreement completely as it is an obligatory part of your online application. Please print this document, sign it and upload it as a scanned attachment (PDF file) in the online application portal or add your signature digitally. **The deadline in the online application portal is the 16th of May 2024, 2:00 p.m.**

1. Declaration of participation

4. Information about data protection

It's up to you which of these you choose: tell us what qualifies you for a Deutschlandstipendium!

We are aware that some of the information is highly confidential. Some of the information (e.g. on health or migration data) is also so-called special types of personal data (Art. 9 DSGVO). Your data will always be treated confidentially and, together with our IT service provider, protected with up-to-date technical security measures. Of course, the members of the selection committee are also bound to secrecy. You can reach our data protection officer at datenschutz@uni-halle.de.

Processing purposes

Your personal data provided here will be collected and processed for the selection of suitable applicants and for the implementation of the Deutschlandstipendium. The legal basis is Art. 6 (1) lit. c DSGVO in conjunction with Section 10 of the Scholarship Programme Act (StipG). According to this, applicants for the scholarship programme are obliged to provide the information required for the examination of the performance and suitability requirements and to submit the corresponding evidence.

According to the Scholarship Programme Act, we are obliged to transmit scholarship holder data to the Federal Statistical Office in order to compile federal statistics. This is done under a pseudonym, i.e. without disclosing your name. The legal basis is Art. 6 (1) lit. c DSGVO in conjunction with Section 13 of the Scholarship Programme Act (StipG).



The Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) also carries out random checks on the data of the funded students in order to avoid double funding. For this purpose, the BMBF may query and store the surname, first name, date of birth, address and university location of individual funded students and compare them with the data of other funding institutions. Martin Luther University is legally obliged to transmit this data. In this respect, there is also a legal basis here according to Art. 6 (1) lit. c DSGVO in conjunction with Section 4 (2) of the Scholarship Programme Act (StipG). After the sample has been carried out, the data will be destroyed by the BMBF.

Categories of recipients

Your personal data will be transferred to web hosting service providers commissioned by us. Data will not be transferred to third countries.

Data subject rights

You have the right to request information at any time about the personal data stored by us and attributable to you (Art. 15 DSGVO). In addition, you have the right to rectification (Art. 16 DSGVO), deletion (Art. 17 DSGVO), restriction of processing (Art. 18 DSGVO), data transfer (Art. 20 DSGVO) and objection (Art. 21 DSGVO).

Obligation to provide personal data

There is no obligation to provide your personal data – apart from the mandatory data mentioned above. The corresponding information is provided voluntarily. If you do not provide this information, you will unfortunately not be able to apply for a Deutschlandstipendium.

Duration of processing/storage

In the case of an unsuccessful application, your documents will be deleted 12 months after the end of the selection procedure, in the case of a successful application 13 years after the end of the funding.

Please avoid photographing your documents with your smartphone or from the screen! Poorly readable documents cannot be included in the application process.
- Your letter of motivation is an important part of your application. We have put together a <u>handout</u> for you on what to consider when writing your letter of motivation. Take time for your motivation letter. Reflect on your personality, your skills and your strengths and remain authentic. Please also note not to use your letter of motivation from previous applications, otherwise you will not be considered for the selection process.

> Subsequent submission of documents

Missing or incomplete documents will not be requested by us. However, you may edit your application in the online portal subsequently. For this purpose, please go back to the start page of the application portal https://bewerbung.dstip.de/uni-halle and sign in to your online account with your e-mail address and the password you set at the beginning. Know you can edit your data and attach further documents. Please note that changes can only be made within the application period (deadline 16th of May 2024 2:00 p.m.).
